

MIGRANT WEEK 2026

Between June 20 and 27, Belo Horizonte holds Migrant Week 2026, an initiative that is part of the national calendar in reference to National Migrant Day (06/19) and World Refugee Day (06/20).

The action is carried out by the City of Belo Horizonte, in conjunction with various institutional partners, civil society and international organizations, reinforcing the municipality's commitment to the promotion of rights, reception and social, economic and cultural inclusion of the migrant and refugee population.

The program articulates different fronts, such as direct service to the population, productive inclusion, training of professionals, social participation and appreciation of cultural diversity.

The highlight of the week is the event "Belo Horizonte without Borders – Culture, rights and meetings", on June 20, which brings together a joint effort of services in the morning and cultural activities in the afternoon, promoting access to rights and intercultural coexistence.
